



Notification of Mae Fah Luang University
The Measure of Monitoring the Spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

According to the severe global outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and human infection as well as human-to-human transmission of COVID-19 in many countries in the world, the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation has announced the measure of monitoring the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (No. 2) in order to take the precaution of the spread of COVID-19.

By virtue of the Mae Fah Luang University Notification of the Measures of Monitoring the Spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) No. 1 and No. 2 issued on 26 January 2020 and 9 February 2020, respectively, MFU shall uplift the Measure of Monitoring the Spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and follow the precautionary measures against the spread of COVID-19 of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation.

By virtue of the authority under Article 26(1) of the Mae Fah Luang University Act B.E. 2541 in conjunction with Item 6 of the Mae Fah Luang University's Regulations on Leave of Absence of University Employees B.E. 2562, Mae Fah Luang University declares the followings:

1. All students and faculty and staff members are not allowed to go abroad from 27 February 2020 onwards until further notice.
2. In cases of permission on overseas visits prior to 27 February 2020, students and faculty and staff members shall consider to cancel or postpone travelling. Any authorized expenses actually incurred prior to the date of the notification can be reimbursed.
3. In cases of working overseas or having any compelling reasons or necessities for unavoidable overseas travelling, the students and faculty and staff members are obliged to ask for President's consideration on a case-by-case basis.

4. Upon arrival in Thailand, the said students and faculty and staff members in No. 3 are obliged to refrain from attending classes or be absent from work for the period of 14 days from the date of their arrival in Thailand. Such refrainment shall not be considered as absence from classes or work and not counted as leave days. The said students and faculty and staff members in No. 3 shall take actions as follows:

4.1 Report via the QR Code

4.2 Strictly comply with precautionary measures against the spread of COVID-19 of the Ministry of Public Health.

If the said students and faculty and staff members in No. 3 display no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 infection within 14 days, they are allowed to attend classes or to work at the university.

5. All invitations to overseas guests related to any MFU activities from 27 February 2020 onwards such as teaching and learning, meetings, conferences, workshops, etc. shall be cancelled or postponed until further notice. Any authorized expenses actually incurred prior to the date of the notification can be reimbursed.

If there is the high level of the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) or any further announcements from the Ministry of Public Health, Mae Fah Luang University shall make a proper announcement immediately.

Please be informed accordingly and take immediate action.
